I have AVP Deficiency (Cranial Diabetes Insipidus)

This condition should **not** be confused with Diabetes Mellitus

Symptoms: Excessive thirst and passing of large volumes of dilute urine. I do not produce a hormone called Vasopressin (AVP) due to my condition which means I get dehydrated very quickly if I do not have fluids and Desmopressin (DDAVP).

Treatment:
